Competitions

Each program is allowed the following number of teams.

Gourmet Meal 3 teams of 3 students
Dessert 3 teams of 2 students

Edible Centerpiece unlimited number of teams of 1 student (15 max. competitors)

Knife Skills unlimited number of teams of 1 student (30 max. competitors)

ProStart Prep 2 teams of 5 students Waiters Relay 3 teams of 3 students

Nonedible centerpiece unlimited number of teams; up to 2 students per team



Competition Flow

Day of Competition:

Report to Check-In at assigned event location - (10 minutes before scheduled time)

Cook (60 minutes, unless otherwise noted on rules)

Floor Critique (5 to 10 minutes)

Judges' Tasting Critique (5 to 10 minutes)

Station Clean-Up (15 minutes)

ProStart Prep – Check rules for flow

Feedback occurs:

- On the competition floor for Team Presentation/Work Skills/Organization as well as Safety and Sanitation.
- •In the reserved judging area for Tasting and Menu & Recipe segments.

Allowable Attendees

Due to the popularity of this event admittance is limited to the following:

Student competitors

Competing students' instructor

1 chaperone for every 10 students

1 school administrator

(all must register via electronic form – to be provided in October)

Program is allowed up to 4 paid additional school attendees. Cost: \$15 each.

Due to liability issues, this event is not open to the public. Parents and family members are not allowed to attend, unless they are designated chaperones. Parking passes will only be issued to judges and volunteers. Chaperones must ride the bus with students.
